Course: Outdoor, heated 50-Meter, 8 lane course. This pool contains non-turbulent lane lines with a 6' minimum depth. Colorado start and automatic timing systems with scoreboard. Warm-up and warm-down lanes will be available for continuous warm-up throughout the meet. Arizona warm up/warm down procedures will be posted and enforced.

Eligibility:

1. Open to any USA Swimming registered athlete holding a current USA Swimming card.
2. All athletes, coaches and officials must be USA Swimming registered prior to the competition. A valid USA Swimming registration card must be presented to the Clerk of Course, if requested. All coaches and officials must wear their current USA Swimming registration in a visible manner.
3. **There will be no deck registrations or deck entries allowed at this meet. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
4. **The Age Group portion is a "Q minus" meet. Age group swimmers may not enter events where they have already achieved the Arizona State Qualifying time.**
5. The Senior portion is a NTS meet. Swimmers may enter either age group events or Senior events for the entire meet. They are not permitted to enter a mixture of age group and senior events. 13-14 age athletes may enter the Senior portion of this meet only if they have achieved the Arizona Senior "Q" time in the events they wish to enter. No swimmer younger than 13 years of age may enter the Senior portion of this meet.
6. Swimmer's age on July 14, 2006 will govern for this meet.
7. **This meet will be capped at 350 age group swimmers and 350 senior swimmers.**
8. Swimmers with a disability are welcome to enter this meet. The coach or entry chairperson must alert the meet director, and referee, as to the need for any special accommodations or seeding arrangements by the postal deadline.

Rules:

1. The current USA Swimming rules for competitive swimming will govern.
2. The Arizona controlled meet warm-up procedure will be enforced and posted.
3. Time trails will not be offered.
4. All events 400 meters and longer will require a ****positive check-in**** with the clerk of course. Check in will close at the start of the session in which that event is swam. Swimmers in the events 400 meters and longer must provide their own timers and personal to count laps.
5. The all events 400 meters and longer will be swum fastest to slowest alternating girls and boys, and some heats may be combined. At the referee's discretion, some or all of heats 800 and longer may be swum two per lane.
6. This is a timed final meet.
7. All swimmers are limited to a maximum of three (3) individual events per session and **(5) individual events for the entire meet. If this rule is broken the highest numbered event(s) will be dropped. No phone calls will be made.**
8. Entry times must be the swimmers' best long course meter (LM) time. If an athlete does not have a LC time then that athlete should be entered with no time (NT). No converted times will be accepted.
