Course: Outdoor, 25 yard, 8 lane heated pool, Colorado Starting system, electronic push button timing.

Eligibility: Open to any USA Swimming registered swimmer from MVAC, TYG, BEST, SWS, VC, & ASG with a current 2006 USA Swimming Registration card as of the meet entry deadline.

Age as of February 10, 2006 will govern this meet.

This is a No Time Standard Meet

There will be no on-deck registrations accepted.

Swimmers with a disability are welcome to enter this meet. The coach or entry chairperson must alert the meet director, referee, and entry coordinator as to the need for any special accommodations or seeding arrangements at the time the entry is submitted.

Rules: The current rules of Competitive Swimming will govern.

Each swimmer may swim up to four individual events. Individual events are pre-seeded and timed finals.

No time trials will be offered

The Arizona Controlled meet warm up will be posted and enforced.

All coaches and officials must be USA Swimming registered prior to the competition, and wear current USA Swimming registration in a visible manner.

The Valley of the Sun Jewish Community Center is a kosher facility and does not allow outside food to be brought into the facility. People above age 16 must show a photo ID and sign in to gain entrance into the facility.

Scoring: The top 8 places per age group will score (9,7,6,5,4,3,2,1). Ribbons will be given 1st through 8th by age group

Entries: Entries must be received by Thursday September 7th. Electronic entries only. Hy-tek entry files must be emailed to neptunenatation@hotmail.com by the deadline. Late entries will be accepted with a \$5 late fee on a space available basis. No event will be reseeded nor any new heats created to accommodate late entries.

Timing: Timers will be needed for all events. Two timers per lane are required. Timing assignments will be made based on the number of swimmers representing each team.
